

## **The 100 Club 2021/22**

We hope that anyone living in Campton & Chicksands will join the 100 Club as a means of assisting, through their financial contribution with the provision, maintenance and development of the facilities of the Village Hall for everyone's future enjoyment.

The basic features of the 100 Club are as follows:

- For a payment of £15 you will be allocated a Draw Number to be entered into 12 consecutive draws from the start of the subscription year plus 3 bonus draws in December, April and August.
- Anyone can buy more than one Draw Number
- All Draw Numbers will be entered into a monthly draw
- Additional subscribers can join during the year on a pro rata basis
- A minimum of half of the total proceeds will be allocated as prizes:  
*As an example based on 130 Draw Numbers being sold, this would give monthly prizes of:*
  - 1<sup>st</sup> monthly prize £35 (50.00% of monthly draw)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> monthly prize £20 (28.57% of monthly draw)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> monthly prize £15 (21.43% of monthly draw)
  - 3 bonus prizes of £50 drawn in December, April and August
- Data Protection: The 100 Club holds details of participants' names and addresses securely. Winners are published in the monthly parish council newsletter and website. This will include the winning numbers, winning names and sums won. If you do not wish your name to be published, please inform the Editor in writing.
- The winning amounts will be issued by cheque and these will be distributed as soon as practicable following the Committee meetings.

## **100 CLUB LOTTERY RULES**

1. The 100 Club will be operated under The Gambling Act 2005, which deals with a Small Society Lottery. The promoter will be the Chairman of the Campton Village Hall Management Committee.
  2. The Village Hall Management Committee reserves the right to alter these rules from time to time, as may be necessary. A copy of the current rules will be available on the parish council website
  3. All profits made by the "100 Club" will be used to support the development and maintenance of the Village Hall.
  4. The Lottery will generally be limited in membership to members who reside within the Campton and Chicksands parish boundary.
  5. The subscription will be £15 per year, collected in a single payment of £15, by cash or cheque made payable to "Campton Village Hall". On receipt of the payment the applicant will be allocated a Draw Number. For each additional annual payment of £15, an additional Draw Number will be allocated.
  6. The 100 Club year will run from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> August.
  7. A draw will take place every month for cash prizes. Winners of prizes will receive a cheque and the results of the draw will be open for inspection and published in the Parish Council newsletter and on the parish council website.
  8. A minimum of 50% of the total annual subscriptions will be paid out in the form of cash prizes.
  9. The draws will be conducted by a minimum of 3 members of the Village Hall Management Committee or, when this is not possible, at a Parish Council meeting.
  10. No participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received. The promoter reserves the right to reallocate any Draw Number where payment has not been received on time.
  11. Prizes will be paid by cheque which will be delivered to the address of the person holding the winning number.
- Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Treasurer. Any decision by Campton Village Hall Management Committee to wind up the 100 Club will also be by one month's written notice. Under no circumstances can payments be refunded.
