- The insurance policy was checked and there is adequate public liability for the recreation ground, Events not organised by the PC need to provide their own insurance and insurance for any companies attending.
- There are lots of nettles on one patch of the recreation ground once again, clerk will discuss the best way to manage this with the grass cutting contractor.
- Cllr Booton has managed to access plans of pipes and cables within the village which will be required when planning tree planting.
- It was agreed that whilst not being a stakeholder or in close proximity to the proposed Greenwood development the ripple effect of such a large development would impact on the parish. Clerk will prepare something to be submitted to CBC, to be agreed by email.
- Cllr Ash has spoken to residents regarding the bench opposite the church, works will be carried out to cut back the hedge.
- A resident planning a village event will forward clerk the insurance and risk assessment.
- Due to commitments the Clerk's availability will be reduced between 21<sup>st</sup> June -2<sup>nd</sup> July, she will be able to respond to emails.
